Start up

1. **Before first use**, clean the parts that will be in contact with food.

2. Install the Pouring Jug (**E**), the Filter (**C**) and the Cone (**B**) on the motor unit (**F**) as shown on the drawing.
Cut a citrus fruit in two and press each half gently onto the cone.
Recover the juice in the pouring jug.
3. On some models, you can use the fountain accessory (**D**) to pour the juice directly into a glass. To do so, place the fountain accessory (**D**) between the pouring jug (**E**) and the sieve (**C**) and then place a glass under the spout.
4. You can also adjust the amount of pulp by changing the position of the cone (**drawing G**):
top position : very little pulp.
bottom position: a lot of pulp.
Never run the citrus press for more than 10 minutes continuously.

Cleaning

- Clean the motor unit with a damp cloth.
- You can wash all other parts in the dishwasher (upper basket).
- Never use bleach or a scouring pad.
- Over time the strong coloured natural juices from food such as carrots and beetroot may stain the sieve- this is normal. It may be cleaned by soaking in milk bleach (not abrasive) straight after use.
